One position (08-024) is for a broadly-trained ecologist whose teaching assignment will include, but not be limited to, Evolution and Ecology, Natural Resource Management, and electives in Biology. The other position (08-025) is for a broadly-trained evolutionary biologist whose teaching assignment will include, but not be limited to, Evolution and Ecology, Genetics, and electives in Biology. Applicants are required to have a Ph.D. in the biological sciences, and give evidence of a strong commitment to teaching and of scholarly achievement. Postdoctoral and teaching experiences preferred.
