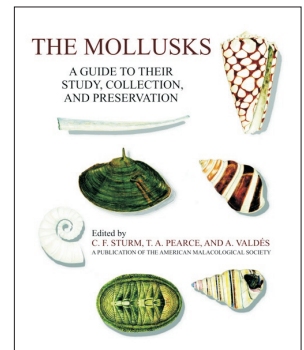


# The Mollusks
